Carpark Conduct and Safety

Please note that owning or driving a car does not purchase a parking space at College. Car parking is at a premium. The student car parks are for parking only. Please park and go directly into the school and then leave when class has finished. Please do not hang out in the car parks. This is to protect everyone's cars from damage and the safety of all.

To help us monitor the use of the car park please register your vehicle at the front office on the form provided and display the permit sticker on your windscreen or dashboard. Then we know that your car should be here.

There will be increased teacher monitoring of the car park for the future to check on driving behaviour, and car park etiquette. The registration numbers of cars that are observed to be driven dangerously (this includes burnouts and excessive speed) will be reported to the AFP. The AFP have indicated that they will be conducting patrols.

Etiquette in the Lake G carpark includes: no visitors with you unless they are recorded as a visitor at the front office, leaving the car park on your arrival and returning to your car when you are leaving, travelling at a safe speed and being mindful of other users, following teacher directions.

An appropriate car park speed is 15kph or slower.

Please be aware there are pedestrian crossings, bus stops and a cycle way in the immediate vicinity of the College. As such all students are responsible for safe conduct in and around the College, and look out for people in our community.

Visiting Other Colleges

Students are not permitted to visit other colleges or schools, in order to maintain a safe environment for all students. We have been working with other colleges around this, and students who visit other colleges will be reported to the AFP as trespassers.
