## COLLEGE LAWYER

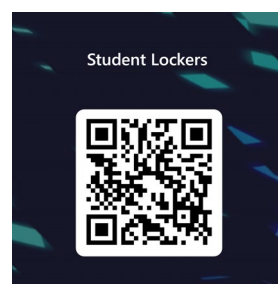
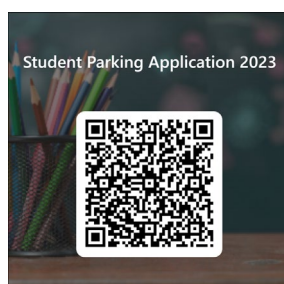
The college lawyer is at Lake Ginninderra College **every second Thursday on 2023**.

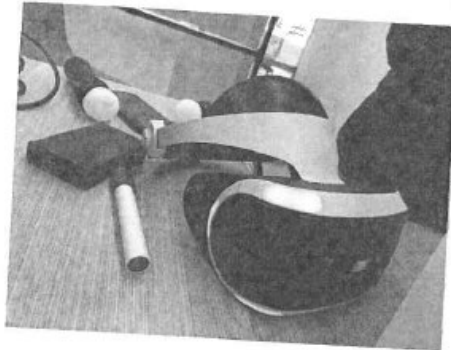
