Come join us at games club **in the library on Friday H-lines till late**. We play games like jackbox, Secret Hitler, Catan, and You've Got Crabs!

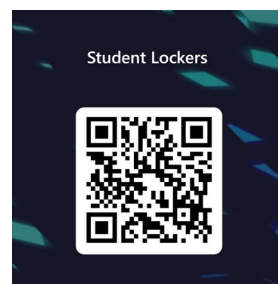
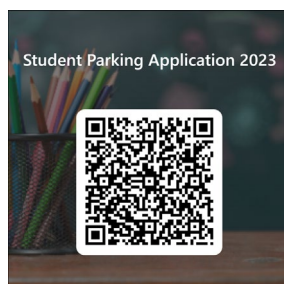
DUNGEONS AND DRAGONS

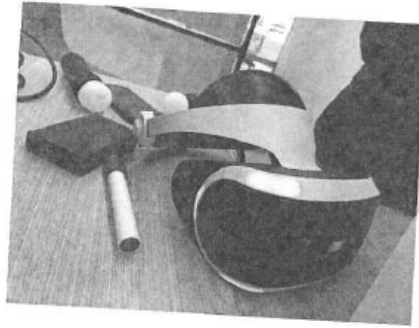
